PARENT / CARER REVIEW MEETINGS

PRICE INCREASES

Due to rising costs in supplies, resources and staffing we regret that we are going to have to announce some price increases from September 2023.

School Dinners

We have held the cost of a school dinner at £1.80 for many years but this price is no longer sustainable. Therefore we are going to have to raise the cost to **£2.00 per school dinner**. This will take effect from **Monday 4th September 2023**.

Breakfast Club

Again, we have held the price of Breakfast Club at £2.50 for a while. The Breakfast Club has never been intended to be profit making and we have always subsidised the cost to some extent. However, the extent to which we are having to subsidise this session is also not sustainable. Therefore from **Monday 4th September** the cost of each **breakfast club session will be £3.50**. You may be able to apply for tax free childcare. This is a government scheme that pays 20% of childcare costs up to a maximum of £2000 each year. The scheme is open to all parents of children under 12. To apply you must open a tax free childcare account online. Both of these decisions were not easy to make and we hope that you understand why we have had to increase the price for these services.
