#### **SMOKING / VAPING**

We have had concerns expressed that parents / carers are vaping on school premises. This is a reminder that smoking and vaping are not permitted in any part of the school's premises and grounds including the entrance area to the school, on land adjacent to the school building (e.g. car parks, garden areas, walkways, playgrounds, playing fields etc.) In line with this expectation, there are no designated smoking or vaping areas provided within the school buildings or grounds.

The smoke free/vape free expectations apply to all events / activities held in the school including before and after school sessions, any meetings organised which are attended by school employees as part of their work and/or visitors to such meetings/events.

#### **CAR PARK**

If you are a blue badge holder use is permitted by the school but the badge must be displayed on the dashboard of your car and the blue badge must be used by the holder only.

#### **PRICE INCREASES**

Due to rising costs in supplies, resources and staffing we regret that we are going to have to announce some price increases from September 2023.

#### **School Dinners**

We have held the cost of a school dinner at £1.80 for many years but this price is no longer sustainable. Therefore we are going to have to raise the cost to £2.00 per school dinner. This will take effect from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023. If you are in receipt of certain benefits you may be entitled to apply for free school meals for your child. #### **Breakfast Club**

Again, we have held the price of Breakfast Club at £2.50 for a while. The Breakfast Club has never been intended to be profit making and we have always subsidised the cost to some extent. However, the extent to which we are having to subsidise this session is also not sustainable. Therefore from **Monday 4**<sup>th</sup> **September** the cost of each **breakfast club session will be £3.50**. You may be able to apply for tax free childcare. This is a government scheme that pays 20% of childcare costs up to a maximum of £2000 each year. The scheme is open to all parents of children under 12.
