Attendance Monitoring : Punctuality

As part of our continual and ongoing monitoring of school attendance we will also be including punctuality as a feature of this activity. The law requires pupils to attend school regularly and this includes arriving on time each day.

When your child arrives late to school, there are many consequences:

- Your child misses out on essential instructions given at the beginning of lessons arriving 5 minutes late each day adds up to missing 3 entire days of learning by the end of the year.
- Your child may feel awkward and embarrassed going into the classroom when everyone else is already settled.
- When your child arrives late everyone loses out the class is disrupted and the teacher must take time away from the other pupils to repeat instructions to your child to allow them to access learning.

When your child arrives late you will be asked to sign them in using the digital screen in the reception area.
